- Safe!



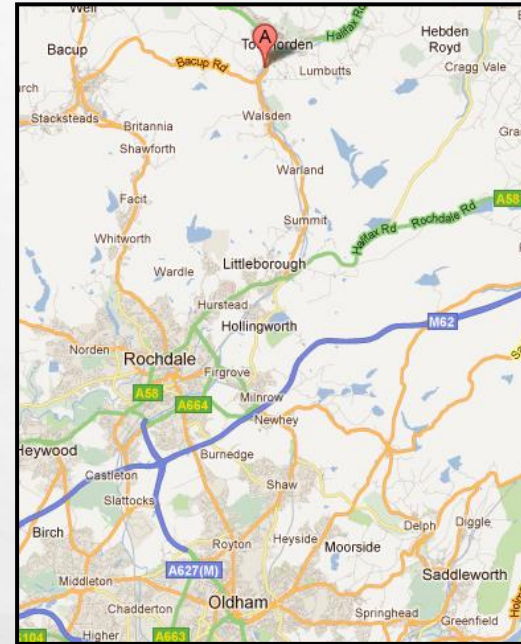

Where is Robinwood?

We are attending 'Dobroyd Castle' in Todmorden.

This is just north of Rochdale.

It is approximately 16 miles away from Alt Academy.

What happens at Robinwood?

Lots of fun activities that encourage children to be independent, solve problems and make memories!

These include abseiling, climbing and canoeing as well as the other activities shown

Children will be split into small groups (up to 10) and each group will have a member of Richmond staff and Robinwood staff with them at all times



What happens at Robinwood?

Children are well-fed throughout their stay with hot meals provided (all halal and all nut free).

Shower and washing times are included on the children's timetables.

They will stay in rooms with friends from school. Girls and boys sleep in separate areas, supervised by Alt and Robinwood staff



Why Robinwood?

Children will learn vital life skills that will help them for the rest of their lives, including:

- Independence
- Problem solving
- Resilience
- Bravery to try new things
- Team work
- Respect

What will my child need?

Please make sure your child has everything on the list – there is no need to buy any new clothes for them to take.
