We have had visitors in to school this week—

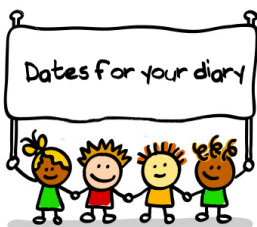
The 'Explorer Dome' came to visit Year 3 and 4 to take us on an amazing interactive journey through the digestive system.
