

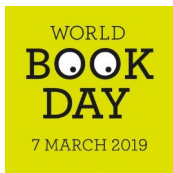

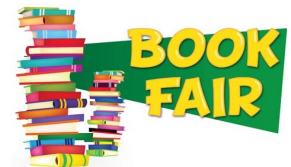
E Safety advice
