ALSO...


It helps your child make friends (in the playground or breakfast club) which leads to improved self-confidence and therefore **SUCCESS**

1. Late before register closes Your child is a few minutes late - but they have missed the opportunity to say hello to and play with friends.

They are likely to feel unsettled and embarrassed as they start morning lessons.

2. Late after register closes

This counts as an unauthorised absence and will show on your child's attendance record. Not only has your child missed the chance to meet with their friends before school, they are likely to have missed the start of lessons and could feel unsettled, embarrassed and much less confident than their classmates as the lesson moves on.
