Year 1 and 2 had a walk to Park Bridge to start their new topic on the local area. They also managed to have a picnic because the weather was so lovely!

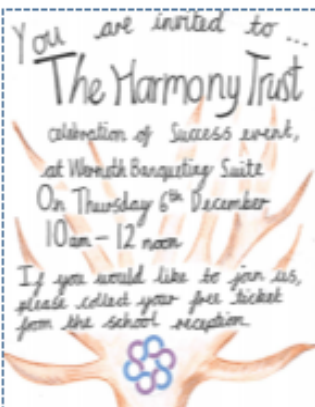
On Wednesday, Aristotle went on their visit to Castleshaw to stimulate their learning on Victorians.
